Adverbs of frequency		
frequency	adverbs	examples
100%	always	You're <b>always</b> late.
90%	usually	We <b>usually</b> go to the cinema on Sunday.
70%	often	He <b>often</b> cooks pasta.
50%	sometimes	We <b>sometimes</b> order pizza for dinner.
10%	hardly ever rarely	She <b>hardly ever</b> smiles.
0%	never	They are <b>never</b> at home when we call.

## Correct Word order

**Subject + Adverb + Main Verb**

Daniel **always** passes his exams.

**Subject + BE + Adverb**

He is **always** happy.
